ARTICLE 29 PROMOTIONAL EXPENSES

1-29-1 Chapter 1: Definitions

The following definitions apply throughout this article:

“**Promotional Expenses**” means expenditures that promote development or tourism, develop relationships with the community or other units of government, or whose purpose is the promotion of Allen County.

1-29-2 Chapter 2: Guidelines

1-29-2-1

The Board of Commissioners considers the following to be **Promotional Expenses**:

- A. expenses incurred in promoting industrial, commercial, and residential development or tourism, including - but not limited to - rental of meeting places, meals, decorations, memorabilia, and awards
- B. expenses incurred in developing relationships with Allen County residents, non-profit groups and other units of government
- C. expenses incurred in commemorative or award plaques, certificates, or other similar items used to recognize the service of county employees
- D. other expenses of a civic or governmental nature deemed by the Board of Commissioners to be in the interest of Allen County.

Promotional Expenses shall be expended by the same method and in the same manner as is required from other county expenditures
