1. **Doc. #10-022, Bruick Drain located in Milan Twp. Sec. 32.** Petitioner – Enos Graber. Petition for encroachment for the installation of a 4-inch perimeter drain tile to connect into the Bruick Drain Tile.
2. **Doc. #10-023, Graham-McCulloch Br. #1 and the D'Andrea Drains located in Aboite Twp. Sec. 24.** Petitioner – Allen County Board of Commissioners. Petition for encroachment for the construction of a 12 foot wide shared-use path for pedestrians, bicycles, and other non-motorized forms of transportation.
3. **Doc. #10-024, Trier Ditch located in Adams Twp. Sec. 11.** Petitioner – New Haven Parks & Recreation.
