

## ALLEN COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD MINUTES REGULAR HEARING

February 12, 2009

9:00 a.m.

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The Allen County Drainage Board convened on Thursday February 12th, 2009. Following introductory remarks Ms Bloom asked for approval of the January 12th, 2009 minutes. Mr. Peters moved for approval of the minutes as they were prepared, second by Ms Bloom. Motion carried.

### **Approval of Petitions:**

(The following reflects a synopsis of action taken by the Allen County Drainage Board. Actual tape recordings of the proceedings are available upon request.)

1. Doc. #09-007 Request from Charles O'Neal to set a hearing date for his Petition to remove Obstruction in Mutual Drain or Natural Surface Water Course.

*Following comments and general discussion by the Board, Mr. Frisinger recommended approval of motion to proceed to hearing. Mr. Peters made a motion to proceed to hearing, second by Ms Bloom. Motion carried.*

2. Doc. #09-006, Request from Engineering Resources, Inc. for approval of Stormwater Management Plan for One Resource Group located at Lafayette and Zubrick Road.

*Following comments and general discussion by the Board, Mr. Frisinger recommended approval. Mr. Peters made a motion to approval Doc. #09-006, second by Ms Bloom. Motion carried.*

3. Doc. #09-005, J. Schneider Drain located in Aboite Twp. Sections 6 and 7. Petitioner is INDOT. Petition for the proposed storm drain manhole, 30" storm drain pipe and riprap at head of recently constructed urban drain, station 375+00 Line "C", as shown on Indiana Department of Transportation plans for Project No. 0100421 (intersection improvement, SR 14 at Allen/Whitley County Line Road). To replace an existing 24" pipe and in accordance with a previous agreement with the developers of the Harrison Fields Subdivision and Allen County.

*Following comments and general discussion by the Board, Mr. Frisinger recommended that the interconnections be made on the structure and that the flows are directed to that and handled with a swale that is set aside through a private party land by easement on the opposite side of 14<sup>th</sup>. His recommendation to the Board is that they approve petition subject to receipt of written agreement from INDOT for the above mention plan changes. Mr. Peters*

*made a motion for approval subject to Surveyor's approval, second by Ms Bloom. Motion carried. Doc. #09-005 approved subject to.*

4. Doc. #09-008, Huguenard #2 Drain located in Washington Twp. Sec. 3. Petitioner is INDOT. Petition to allow construction of a new cross structure enclosing the Huguenard Drain under SR 3. 170 feet of 10 Ft x 6 ft concrete box will extend from the west side of SR 3 to the east side and outfall into the existing Huguenard Drain. The Cross section area necessary to convey the water is 10 ft x 5 ft. The box will be sumped 1 foot.

*Following comments and general discussion by the Board, Mr. Frisinger recommended deferral until the February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2009 meeting. Mr. Peters made a motion to defer until the February 26<sup>th</sup> meeting, second by Ms Bloom. Motion carried.*

5. Doc. #09-009, Braun Drain located in Washington Twp. Sec. 15. Petitioner is INDOT. Petition to construct a new cross structure enclosing the Braun Drain under SR 3 at Ludwig Road. Reconstruction of SR 3 through Fort Wayne north of I-69 interchange.

*Following comments and general discussion by the Board, Mr. Frisinger recommended deferral until the February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2009 meeting. Mr. Peters made a motion to defer until the February 26<sup>th</sup> meeting, second by Ms Bloom. Motion carried.*

Other Business:

The City of Fort Wayne has asked the Drainage Board to have hearings on the Braun and Beckman Drains. The Board asked Mr. Frisinger to proceed to hearing on these drains. He will set hearing dates.

Dunfee Drain. Mr. Frisinger informed the Board that he will be setting a hearing date for a public hearing on the Dunfee Drain.

Ellis McFadden address not given.

*Mr. McFadden asked for help on the Snyder Ditch. It was explained to him that they are preparing to take the drain to hearing, but in the past property owners refused to support work being done on the drain.*
